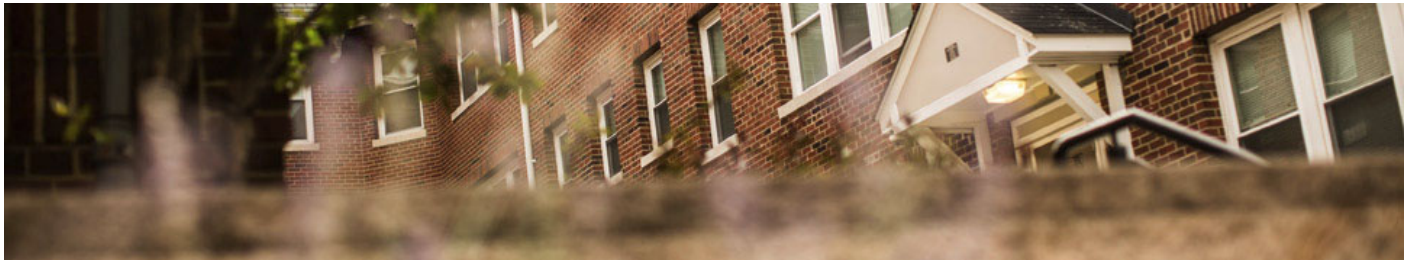

These activities promote economic opportunity and impact real lives nationwide.

These awards can be used to finance affordable housing activities, as well as related economic development activities and community service facilities.

[CDFI Bond Guarantee Program › \(/programs-training/Programs/cdfi-bond/Pages/default.aspx\)](#) Through the CDFI Bond Guarantee Program, the Secretary of the Treasury makes debt available to CDFIs from the Federal Financing Bank. The loans provide long-term capital not previously available to CDFIs, and inject new and substantial investment into our nation's most distressed communities.

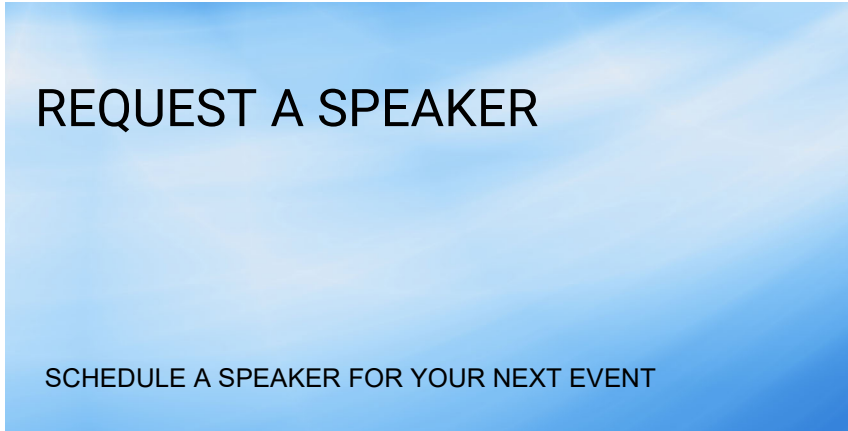
