

Figure VI: Survey Results of Prioritization of Diabetes Care Areas Compared to Baseline: Ten of the top eleven prioritized diabetes care areas are equivalent within the baseline and survey group. The baseline group rated stress as the eighth most important diabetes care area while the survey group scored it as the twelfth most important. One potential reason could be that the baseline group rated this while building an employee ACO program, in which stress is apparent. Those surveyed rated this in the context of their diabetes expertise and experience. Overall, scores are inflated within the survey group as a result of increased weight scores applied to the survey group
